IDEAL STEPS IN PRESERVING PHOTOGRAPHS

- Photographs should be kept in a cool, dark area; never a hot attic.
- Changes in temperature and humidity are harmful on photos.
- Handle photographs by the edges and avoid touching the surface. Oils on the hands and fingers will promote deterioration.
- To identify photographs, use a Number 2 pencil and write lightly in the upper or lower margin on the back of photograph.
- Have a copy made of old, faded, or deteriorated photographs.
- Never use pressure sensitive (scotch) tape on photos. The tape will eventually stain the photo and is hard to remove.
- Photographs should be stored flat, preferably separated by acid-free tissue, or PVC free plastic sleeves.
- Photo Albums filled with acid-free scrapbook pages with archival quality polyester film covers are recommended; avoid the magnetic, self-stick albums.
- Care and store them properly; don't be afraid to handle the records. A letter or photograph you are afraid to touch has little value.

Bring your photos to the Museum to add to our collection; or we will scan them for you.
